OZ Lotto

OZ Lotto is an exciting seven number game with seven prize divisions. A ticket in the OZ Lotto draw every Tuesday gives players the best odds of winning a prize of any of our Lotto games.

Every Tuesday night the OZ Lotto draw machine randomly selects balls numbered from 1 to 45. Nine balls in total are chosen. The first seven are called the Winning Numbers. There are two more balls chosen and these are called Supplementary Numbers.

Prices are in the Cost of Entry brochure, which is available from Lotterywest retailers and on the Lotterywest website.

You can buy OZ Lotto tickets up to 6.00pm on Tuesdays.

Ticket Repeat

You can select your numbers to enter future OZ Lotto draws by presenting an existing ticket (including Slikpiks) and requesting the same type of ticket and combination of numbers. Just ask your Lotterywest retailer about the Ticket Repeat option.

How do I win?

OZ Lotto has seven prize divisions. The more Winning Numbers you have, the bigger the prize.

Jackpots

Sometimes no one wins Division One and the prize pool is carried forward to the next draw. This is called a 'jackpot' and it can happen over two or more consecutive draws. It costs the same to play in a jackpot week as it does for other draws.

More ways to play

Multiweek

If you have a set of lucky numbers that you always play, you don't have to fill out a playslip or visit your Lotterywest retailer every week. You can play the same numbers for 2, 5 or 10 weeks by marking the appropriate 'Number of Weeks' box on the playslip.

Advance Wagering

To buy an OZ Lotto ticket up to nine weeks ahead of the current draw, just mark the Advance Play box on the playslip and advise your Lotterywest retailer of the draw you wish to enter.

Syndicates

Another way to play OZ Lotto is to play as a team. You share the cost of the tickets and if your OZ Lotto syndicate wins, you all win! You can join a syndicate at your Lotterywest retailer or create one with your friends, family or workmates. Ask your Lotterywest retailer about syndicate options.



Systems

A Systems entry is a quick and easy way to increase the number of games you play in a draw. The more games you play in a draw, the better your chances of winning. Systems can be played by selecting your own numbers on a playslip, or as a Slikpik.

There are two types of Systems games.

Fewer numbers

These increase your chances of winning by reducing the number of correct Winning Numbers you need. For example, with a System 5, you only need five Winning Numbers to win the Division One prize. With a System 6, you need six Winning Numbers to win Division One. A System 5 costs more than a System 6 because you are guaranteed two numbers instead of one.

More numbers

These increase your chances of winning by giving you more numbers in each game. With Systems 8 through to 20, you have more numbers in each draw, and more chances to win.

How do I fill in a playslip to play Systems?

On the front of the playslip mark a cross in the Systems box you want to play with a BLUE or BLACK PEN, or PENCIL. Then mark the game panel with the appropriate amount of numbers for the System, eg: System 8, mark 8 numbers. System 9, mark 9 numbers. Systems can also be played as Slikpiks.

Note: In Western Australia, you can only buy an individual, receipted ticket with a value not exceeding \$100,000.

Winning more than one prize

With a Systems entry you can win more than one prize with one entry. Here's an example:

Let's say you have an OZ Lotto System 8 entry and five of your numbers are drawn (for example the combination of 1, 2, 3, 4, 5). If you were to write out every combination of the eight games a System 8 entry gives you, you'd find that you have won three Division 5 prizes and five Division 6 prizes. See table below.

What do Systems entries cost?

Systems entries cover multiple combinations of numbers so they naturally cost more than a normal entry. Prices are in the Cost of Entry brochure, which is available from Lotterywest retailers and on the Lotterywest website.

Super 66

You can also play Super 66 when you play OZ Lotto. The idea of the game is to match your 6 numbers – in order from either left or right – with the 6 Winning Numbers drawn each Saturday night just prior to the Saturday Lotto draw. The more numbers you match in order, the bigger your prize.

There are five prize divisions, and you can win with as few as two consecutive numbers in the same order from either end. Ask your Lotterywest retailer or pick up a Lotto brochure for more information.

Check your ticket

Please check your OZ Lotto ticket before you leave your Lotterywest retailer. Check the numbers you wish to play have been correctly selected and make sure you are in the draw you want to play. Prizes can only be paid if you have a valid and correct ticket so it is up to you to check you've got the numbers you want in the draw you want.

After the draw you can find out if you have won a prize by using the Lotterywest Ticket Checker. Visit your Lotterywest retailer and scan your ticket barcode to see if you're a winner!

Draw results

The OZ Lotto draw results are on television every Tuesday night. Check your local television guide for details.

If you miss the draw results or want to check your numbers, use the Ticket Checker at any Lotterywest retailer, visit our website at www.lottoresults.net, or call 1900 919 958 (Dialect Interactive. Calls cost 44 cents per minute including GST. Mobiles and pay phones extra). Results are also published by Lotterywest in The West Australian newspaper.



Collecting your prize

Division 1

You can collect your Division One winnings following a validation period that ends 14 days after the draw. Present your winning ticket and claim your prize at Lotterywest, 74 Walters Drive, Osborne Park, during Monday – Friday office hours. If you live outside the metropolitan area or can't get to our offices, you can post it to PO Box 1113, Osborne Park 6917.

Divisions 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7

You can claim your prize from Lotterywest, 74 Walters Drive, Osborne Park, or at any Lotterywest retailer, the day after the draw. Lotterywest retailers have a \$500 cash payout limit and amounts greater than this may be claimed subject to cash availability. Please check with your retailer.

Under the Lotteries Commission Act, 1990, prizes can only be claimed and paid for up to 12 months after the date of the draw. After this period the ticket is no longer valid. Unclaimed prizes are returned to the Western Australian community via Lotterywest grants.

And remember, your winning ticket is a bearer ticket. It's just like cash, so please keep it safe at all times.

Official OZ Lotto Rules

When you play OZ Lotto you agree to be bound by the rules governing the game. A printed copy is available to view at your Lotterywest retailer or on the Lotterywest website www.lotterywest.com.au

If any conflict should occur between the Rules and information contained in this brochure, the Rules must take precedence.

You must be 16 years of age or older to play any Lotterywest games.
