# Soccer Pools

## Even if you don't know Soccer, it's fun and easy to play

Soccer Pools is similar to Lotto but instead of coloured balls chosen by a machine, the numbers are determined by the results of soccer games played in the southern and northern hemispheres.

Prices are in the Cost of Entry brochure, which is available from Lotterywest retailers and on the Lotterywest website.

Soccer Pools entries close on Saturday, and closing times depend on the southern and northern hemisphere soccer seasons. Ask your Lotterywest retailer to confirm the current closing times.

You simply choose 6 numbers from 38. The more Winning Numbers you choose, the more prize money you can win.

Each week you'll find a soccer Match List at your Lotterywest retailer. 38 matches are listed and each game is given a number from 1 to 38.

The matches on the Match List for a Soccer Pools game are ranked in the order of Score Draws, Scoreless Draws, Away Wins and Home Wins.

Finally, give the playslip to your Lotterywest retailer who will process it through the terminal and give it back to you with a print out of your chosen numbers. This is your ticket and is needed to claim prizes, so please keep it in a safe place.

### Slikpiks

Slikpiks are tickets of randomly selected numbers produced by the terminal. A Slikpik 25 is a popular choice, but there are also 50, 30, 18 and 12 game Slikpiks.

### Ticket Repeat

You can select your numbers to enter future Soccer Pools games by presenting an existing ticket (including Slikpiks) and requesting the same type of ticket and combination of numbers. Just ask your Lotterywest retailer about our Ticket Repeat option.



## How do I win?

With Soccer Pools, just like Lotto, the more winning numbers you have, the more you win. There are five prize Divisions:

<b>DIVISION 1:</b>	You've selected all 6 Winning Numbers.
<b>DIVISION 2:</b>	You've got 5 Winning Numbers plus the Supplementary Number.
<b>DIVISION 3:</b>	You have 5 of the Winning Numbers.
<b>DIVISION 4:</b>	You've selected 4 of the Winning Numbers.
<b>DIVISION 5:</b>	You have 3 Winning Numbers and the Supplementary Number

## Jackpots

Sometimes no one wins Division One and the prize pool is carried forward to the next game. This is called a 'jackpot' and it can happen over two or more consecutive games. It costs the same to play in a jackpot week as it does for other games.

## What are the odds?

# More ways to play

## Multiweek

If you have a set of lucky numbers that you always play, you don't have to fill out a playslip or visit your Lotterywest retailer every week. You can play the same numbers for 2, 5 or 10 weeks by marking the appropriate 'Number of Weeks' box on the playslip.

## Advance Wagering

To buy a Soccer Pools ticket up to nine weeks ahead of the current draw, just mark the 'Advance Play' box on the playslip and advise your Lotterywest retailer of the game you wish to enter.

## Syndicates

Another way to play Soccer Pools is to play as a team. You share the cost of the tickets and if your Soccer Pools syndicate wins, you all win! You can join a syndicate at your Lotterywest retailer or create one with your friends, family or workmates. Ask your Lotterywest retailer about syndicate options.

# Systems

A Systems entry is a quick and easy way to increase the number of games you play. The more games you play, the better your chances of winning. Systems can be played by selecting your own numbers on a playslip, or as a Slikpik.

There are two types of Systems games.

## Fewer numbers

These increase your chances of winning by reducing the number of correct Winning Numbers you need. With a System 4, you only have to select 4 of the Winning Numbers to win Division One. With System 5 you only have to select 5 of the Winning Numbers for a Division One win. A System 4 costs more than a System 5 because you are guaranteed two numbers instead of one.

## More numbers

These increase your chances of winning by giving you more numbers in each game. With Systems 7 to 20 you have more numbers in each game, and more chances to win the big one.

## How do I fill in a playslip to play Systems?

On the front of the playslip mark a cross in the Systems box you want to play with a BLUE or BLACK PEN, or PENCIL. Then mark the game board with the appropriate amount of numbers for the System, eg: System 8, mark 8 numbers. System 9, mark 9 numbers. Systems can also be played as Slikpiks.

Note: In Western Australia, you can only buy an individual, receipted ticket with a value not exceeding \$100,000.

# Winning more than one prize

With a systems entry you can win more than one prize with one entry. Here's an example:

## What do Systems entries cost?

Systems entries cover multiple combinations of numbers so they naturally cost more than a normal entry. Prices are in the Cost of Entry brochure, which is available from Lotterywest retailers and on the Lotterywest website.

# Super 66

You can also play Super 66 when you play Soccer Pools. The idea of the game is to match your 6 numbers – in order from either left or right – with the 6 Winning Numbers drawn each Saturday night just prior to the Saturday Lotto draw. The more numbers you match in order, the bigger your prize.

There are five prize divisions, and you can win with as few as two consecutive numbers in the same order from either end. Ask your Lotterywest retailer or pick up a Lotto brochure for more information.

Prices are in the Cost of Entry brochure, which is available from Lotterywest retailers and on the Lotterywest website.

# Check your ticket

Please check your Soccer Pools ticket before you leave your Lotterywest retailer. Check the numbers you wish to play have been correctly selected and make sure you are in the game you want to play. Prizes can only be paid if you have a valid and correct ticket so it is up to you to check you've got the numbers you want in the game you want.

After the game you can find out if you have the winning numbers using the Lotterywest Ticket Checker. Visit your Lotterywest retailer and scan your ticket barcode to see if you're a winner!

Soccer Pools results are published in The West Australian newspaper every Wednesday.

# Collecting your prize

## Division 1

You can collect your Division One winnings following a validation period that ends 14 days after the draw. Present your winning ticket and claim your prize at Lotterywest, 74 Walters Drive, Osborne Park, during Monday – Friday office hours. If you live outside the metropolitan area or can't get to our offices, you can post it to PO Box 1113, Osborne Park 6917.

## Divisions 2, 3, 4 and 5

Winners can claim their prizes from Lotterywest at Osborne Park, or at any Lotterywest retailer, two working days after the draw. Lotterywest retailers have a \$500 cash payout limit and amounts greater than this may be subject to cash availability. Please check with your retailer.

**Under the Lotteries Commission Act, 1990, prizes can only be claimed and paid for up to 12 months after the date of the draw. After this period the ticket is no longer valid. Unclaimed prizes are returned to the Western Australian community via Lotterywest grants.**

And remember, your winning ticket is a bearer ticket. It's just like cash, so please keep it safe at all times.

# Official Soccer Pools Rules
