

2006 Lotterywest Interpretation of Cultural Heritage Grants Program

Grant applications were invited for projects to interpret cultural heritage places and objects.

Applications closed 7 July 2006.

Grants approved in 2006 are listed below, and totalled \$381,477.

Australian Railway Historical Society (W.A. Division) Inc	\$14,000 for historical research and the collection of stories relating to rail operations and travellers experiences.
Carnarvon Heritage Group Inc	\$15,000 for an Interpretation Plan for a site which contains a Jetty, Tramway and Lighthouse Keeper's Cottage.
City of Albany	\$15,000 for research, design and text development relating to signage at the Amity site which contains the Old Goal and the Brig Amity.
City of Armadale	\$8,503 to install interpretive signage to recognise the personal stories relating to many displaced families who immigrated to Australia from Europe and were placed in migrant camps following World War Two.
City of Armadale	\$13,000 towards an Interpretation Plan and style guide to assist in the development of interpretive strategies at two local history museums in Armadale.
City of Fremantle	\$8,551 for recording equipment and a historian to record oral histories with 20 Fremantle artists who are represented in the City of Fremantle art collection.
City of South Perth-May & Herbert Gibbs Collection	\$13,030 to digitise, develop interpretive material and provide web access for this collection which contains works depicting the history of South Perth.
City of Wanneroo	\$15,000 to research and collect stories relating to the experiences of Aboriginal people and their connection with the history of Wanneroo.
Collie Heritage Group Inc.	\$12,610 to produce and install 'The Age of Steam' exhibition which depicts the significance of rail and coal to the history of Collie.
Leonora Gwalia Historical Museum Ltd	\$15,000 towards the production of interpretive material at this unique mining heritage townsite.
National Trust of Australia (WA) - Ellensbrook Interpretation Project	\$15,000 for the installation of interpretation at Ellensbrook Homestead.
National Trust of Australia (WA) - Fremantle Artillery Drill Hall	\$14,550 towards interpretive elements including the use of early paint colour schemes and text and graphics at the Drill Hall.
Northampton Historical Society Inc	\$15,000 to prepare an Interpretation Plan for Port Gregory.
Roman Catholic Bishop of Broome - Luurnpa Catholic School	\$15,000 to produce a DVD to capture the history connected to the education of Aboriginal people from the Great Sandy Desert region.
Shire of Busselton	\$15,000 towards an Interpretation and Design plan for the old goal and courthouse complex.
Shire of Capel	\$12,500 towards the first stage in the preparation of an Interpretation Plan for the Boyanup Museum
Shire of Cunderdin	\$15,000 towards the preparation of an Interpretation Plan for the World War Two Airfield at Cunderdin.
Shire of Dowerin	\$13,000 for an Interpretation Plan for a range of sites in the Shire of Dowerin which include waterholes, railway heritage and commercial buildings.

Shire of Greenough	\$5,000 for an Interpretation Plan for Bootenal Springs which has strong links to the European and Aboriginal history of the Greenough Flats.
Shire of Merredin	\$15,000 for an Interpretation Plan for Merriden Peak which has Aboriginal, natural and cultural heritage significance.
Shire of Murray - Old Cooper's Mill	\$15,000 towards the implementation of external signage and appropriate landscaping at a former flour mill on Cooleenup Island in the Murray River near Pinjarra.
Shire of Waroona	\$15,000 to prepare an Interpretation Plan for Hamel Precinct which has cultural, natural and Aboriginal heritage significance.
Shire of West Arthur	\$11,463 for an Interpretation Plan for Arthur River townsite.
Shire of Woodanilling	\$15,000 for an Interpretation Plan for the Shire of Woodanilling.
Town of Claremont	\$1,750 to plan an appropriate heritage garden for Anzac Cottage.
Town of Claremont - Claremont Museum	\$14,820 to develop a recognisable visual identity and design a suite of signs for installation within and around the Claremont Museum.
Tractor Museum of W.A. (Inc.)	\$13,700 to develop and train volunteers to undertake live guide tours at the tractor Museum in Whiteman Park.
Waugal Aboriginal Corporation	\$15,000 to prepare an exhibition of artworks and interpretive panels based on stories recorded by Daisy Bates from the Murray region in the early 1900's.
Wila Gutharra Community Aboriginal Corporation	\$15,000 to prepare an Interpretation Plan for the Old School in Northampton.
