

# **“TODAY TONIGHT SATURDAY LOTTO MEGADRAW” COMPETITION**

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

By entering the “Today Tonight Saturday Lotto Megadraw” Competition, you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

### **1. STANDARD TERMS**

- 1.1 Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry.

### **2. WHO CAN ENTER?**

- 2.1 Subject to clause 2.2, entry is open to all residents of Western Australia that are over the age of 16 years and where the Channel Seven signal is received.
- 2.2 Employees and their immediate families of Seven Network (Operations) Limited and Lotterywest and their associated agencies and companies are not eligible to enter.

### **3. HOW TO ENTER**

- 3.1 The competition commences on Monday 26 December 2011 at 6.30pm (WST) and concludes on Friday 30 December 2011 at 7.00pm (WST) inclusive (“Competition Period”).
- 3.2 In order to enter, viewers must purchase a Slikpik 30 in the Saturday Lotto \$31 Million New Year’s Eve Megadraw (Draw 3177) from a Lotterywest retailer or through the Lotterywest website and watch Channel Seven Perth between 6.30pm and 7.00pm (WST) during the Competition Period.

### **4. PRIZES**

- 4.1 There will be five winners. Each winner will win \$5,000.
- 4.2 The total prize pool is AU\$25,000 inclusive of GST.
- 4.3 The winners are responsible for all other expenses, including all costs associated with collection of the prize.
- 4.4 Regional winners must contact Lotterywest on (08) 9340 5200 to make arrangements for their prize to be awarded.

- 4.5 In participating in the competition, the winners agree to participate and cooperate as required in all editorial activities relating to the Competition, including but not limited to being interviewed and photographed. The winners (and their companions) agree to grant the promoter a perpetual and non-exclusive licence to use such footage and photographs in all media worldwide and the winners (and their companions) will not be entitled to any fee for such use.
- 4.6 Entrants may enter more than once, but can only win once.
- 4.7 Entrants in the competition must be 16 years of age or over at the time of purchasing their Lotto ticket.
- 4.8 Prizes cannot be transferred.
- 4.9 Winners should seek independent financial advice about any tax implications that may arise from the prize winnings.
- 4.10 Should the seventh caller not be eligible to win the nightly prize the next caller with a valid ticket may win the nightly prize subject to verification of their ticket.

- 5.1 Each day during the Competition Period a competition segment will be telecast between 6.30pm and 7.00pm (WST), which will feature a number between 1 and 45. Viewers will be prompted to call Channel Seven on 9484 7777 if their valid Slikpik 30 ticket in the Saturday Lotto \$31 Million New Year's Eve Megadraw (Draw 3177) features the same number in game row 30. (This number will change daily.) The seventh caller with the correct number in game row 30 on their Slikpik 30 ticket (Draw 3177) will win the nightly prize upon verification of the ticket's serial number.
- 5.2 Should the seventh caller be ineligible to win the nightly prize, the next caller will be taken.
- 5.3 In order to claim their prize, metropolitan viewers will need to produce two forms of personal identification, one with photographic identification to Lotterywest, 74 Walters Drive, Osborne Park.
