

WA shares the love of HOME and the \$20 million Saturday Lotto Superdraw

WA is sharing all the love this weekend with the \$20 million Saturday Lotto Superdraw and the Perth International Arts Festival's Lotterywest Festival Opening HOME at Langley Park in Perth, the day before Valentine's Day.

"It would be great to have another winner here and make someone's Valentine's Day dreams come true."

It's not only WA Superdraw winners following tomorrow night's draw that will have reason to celebrate, WA Lotto and scratchie players raised \$283 million for the local community last financial year.
