What is a syndicate?

A syndicate is a team of people who play together to share the cost of the ticket and any winnings. By pooling your money together, you can play more games and increase your chances of winning! Plus it's also more fun playing in a team. Syndicates are available for Saturday Lotto, Monday and Wednesday Lotto, OZ Lotto and Powerball. You can also play Systems as part of a syndicate. So get your dream team together and start playing today!



Tip for Lotterywest members

You can register your share of a syndicate, multiple shares or all shares by asking your retailer to scan your membership card when creating your player syndicate in-store. Just remember, if the syndicate wins a prize, all syndicate shares that are registered to your individual membership must be presented together with your card to claim the prize money.

How can I be part of a syndicate?

1. Buy a share in-store

Visit a Lotterywest store to buy a share in a syndicate. Simply ask what shares are available for the game you want to play or how much you would like to spend.

Scan your Lotterywest membership if you have one to make sure your ticket is registered so you don't miss out on claiming your winnings.

2. Create your own

You can start a syndicate with your work colleagues, friends, family or even your neighbours! The syndicate planner on the Lotterywest website is a great place to start.

1. Pick your team and cost per person

You need a minimum of 5 people and minimum total spend of \$25.

2. Select and buy your ticket

Choose your game and ticket options. If you're unsure what to play, simply tell your retailer how much you have to spend and they can advise on the best option with the most chances to win!

3. Share the excitement

Let your retailer know how many people are in your team and they will provide you with syndicate share tickets for you to hand out to each person.

More ways to play

Systems

Systems are a way of playing where you get more numbers in each game, or reduce the number of Winning Numbers you need to win a prize. The more games you play in each draw, the better your chances of winning because Systems generate combinations of numbers to increase your odds. And because this ticket type multiplies the number of games you're playing, a winning entry pays multiple prizes. It's not magic, it's just Systems!

Combo Packs

Why play one, when you can play them all? Combo Packs are an easy way to play a range of Lotto games across the week in just one purchase. To make things even easier, all tickets are Slikpik entries so there's no need to fill in a playslip. Combo Packs are available exclusively in-store and there's a range of different options to choose from.

Advance Play

Going away? There's no reason to miss a draw! Stay in the game with Advance Play. Enter a draw up to nine weeks in advance for Lotto games and six draws in advance for Set for Life and Cash 3. Whether you're buying a Slikpik ticket or using a playslip, simply let your retailer know which draw you want to enter. You can also Advance Play your entries when you purchase online or through the app.

Multiweek

If you like to play the same numbers every week, save some time with a Multiweek ticket. Get ahead and buy tickets for draws up to ten weeks in advance for your favourite Lotto games*. Your numbers will play automatically so all you have to do is sit back and relax.

Whether you are buying a Slikpik ticket or using a playslip, let your retailer know how many weeks you wish to play.

Playslips

Everyone has their favourite numbers, and playslips are the best way to use them. You can create tickets using your own numbers in-store, online or with the Lotterywest App.

If you're using your numbers in-store, follow the instructions on the back of the playslip and hand this over to receive your ticket.

You can also ask to save these numbers to your Lotterywest membership so you'll be able to use them again easily in the future. Plus with your Lotterywest membership you can store up to 20 sets of favourite numbers per game (except Super66).

Slikpiks

If you're a no fuss kind of Lotto player, this is by far the quickest and easiest way to play. Just pick the draw, choose an option to match your budget, and we'll give you a ticket of randomly generated numbers. Too easy!

Make sure you keep your ticket in a safe place - it needs to be presented to claim a prize if you're a winner! Before you leave the store please check your ticket carefully to ensure the numbers, number of games, number of draws and the draw date on your ticket are what you've chosen.
