"They're perfect for each other and as the kids are still studying, I just had to help with their big day," said the woman.

A year on from winning \$2,222,222 in Saturday Lotto, a couple from Woodlands have used their prize money to celebrate their 25th wedding anniversary back in their honeymoon location. The couple hadn't travelled to Canada since they got married and found it magical to re-live their special holiday from a quarter of a century ago.

After winning \$23.3 million in a Powerball draw in November 2015, a young engaged couple from Cockburn said that their wedding, which they thought would take many years to save up for, could happen much earlier. They were also excited about sharing the joy of their win with their family and making a real difference to the lives of others.

An engaged couple from Greenfields were 'over the moon' to win nearly \$350,000 in a Saturday Lotto draw in November 2015 so they could begin planning their wedding and honeymoon.
