"That's really important to me."

WA's newest multimillionaires said they'd plan to keep on working.

"I really love my job and we're both happy doing what we're doing."

"I'm still a bit stunned. I know it won't sink in until I see those zeroes in my bank account

The winning ticket was purchased from City News Kalgoorlie and is the first Division One win for the store.

Owner of the store Tania Parkes said she was delighted her store could give the life-changing news to the multimillionaires.
