The regular player said he always has his Lotto tickets in his wallet but never really pays attention to the draw dates or numbers.

Every few weeks he gives the pile of tickets to his mum to check so she can have the thrill of the prize reveal.

But this time on a whim, he unsuspectingly went into his favourite Lotterywest store, Gateway News and Lottery Centre, to check the tickets himself.

"I was just talking to the staff at the store about the missing ticket and who it could be - turned out it was me!" said the man.

He said he'd been caring for his mum who's been battling cancer for the last five months and said the big win had brought a burst of energy to the close knit family.

"As a family we often talk about what it would be like to win and now we're experiencing it and it feels great!" he said.

With his \$408,233 prize, the winner plans to reunite his mum with her sister who lives interstate and treat them to a cruise.

"I may retire early, although I enjoy my job so much I might just go casual," he said.

"I don't really need anything but I've had my eye on a new phone and might upgrade my car, but there's no rush.

"Fingers crossed the good news continues this week and mum gets the all clear so our family can enjoy good times ahead."

The happy-go-lucky winner says he'll keep playing Lotto because it feels good to give back, with funds spent on tickets supporting the Western Australian community.

"I better let mum check the tickets next time!" he said.
