"Every week I'd buy a ticket, making sure my favourite numbers 2 and 5 were somewhere in each," he said.

"My mates would always tease me for playing, saying I'm only dreaming," he said.

"Look who's laughing now!"

The man plans to take holidays to Asia, get a new car, and help his four siblings with his new found fortune.
